We have had instruction in all the following areas, as per Section 100.10 of the Regulations of the New York State Commissioner of Education and Melody's Individualized Home Instruction Plan (IHIP): Reading, Writing, Spelling, Language Arts, Arithmetic, U.S. History, Geography, Citizenship, Science, Health, Physical Education, Music, and Visual Arts.

Math	is working on Teaching Textbooks 4 daily. He has completed more than 75% of the curriculum after just starting it at the beginning of September. He is also enjoying practicing his math facts through Reflex Math.
Spelling	is working on Explode the Code Online. He started at Book 1 as review and has completed Book 3. He will continue in the series next quarter.
Writing & English Language	has enjoyed fiction and non-fiction literature. He has done work in writing, spelling, grammar, and vocabulary through regular activities involving speaking, listening, reading and writing. We spend time each day practicing fluency while reading aloud using All About Reading 4. He has made excellent progress through AAR and is over half way through.
Geography	We have been reading History Odyssey Ancient History covering topics such as continents, countries, climate, latitude, longitude, etc.
History	We have read through History Odyssey Ancient History. We've been reading through a variety of texts including fiction and non-fiction books as well as timeline work.
Science	Scientific investigation has included integrated reading, discussion, exploration, observation, experimentation and the use of scientific tools for inquiry. has especially enjoyed group science classes and science read alouds.
Health Education	Health and safety issues have been explored through healthful living practices and timely discussions & advice. Topics have included nutrition, exercise, hygiene, disease and accident prevention, and drug/tobacco/alcohol awareness, traffic and fire safety.
Music	Regular opportunities for singing, listening, performing, and responding to different types of music and instruments have been provided.
Visual Arts	has participated in group art classes, worked on personal art projects.
